## RECODER REPORT

ISLAMABAD: A day after the resignation of Aysha Gulalai, who had been an MNA of the PTI, a lawyer filed a petition before the Election Commission, calling for the disqualification of Tehreek-e-Insaf chairman Imran Khan for his alleged harassment of women parliamentarians.

The petition of Raja Basharat Mehmood asked for by-election at NA-56, a constituency from which Imran Khan is a member of the National Assembly.

Ayesha Gulalai had announced her exit from the PTI on Tuesday over allegations that Imran Khan had been forwarding inappropriate and explicit text messages to party women since as early as October 2013.

# Rabbani urges state institutions to march in unison

QUETTA: The Senate Chairman, Raza Rabbani, has said on Wednesday that there should not be any confrontation among state institutions and that the parliament stands quite weak today.

Rabbani addressed a seminar in Balochistan capital on Wednesday and in his speech he said that all political parties need to walk side by side in order to make Pakistan a developed and stable state.

The ceremony was organised in connection with efforts for peace and stability taken since August 8, 2016 tragedy. Last year in August, over 70 lawyers were killed and scores wounded in a suicide blast that targeted civil hospital.

The speakers at the ceremony

remembered the lawyers who lost their lives in the attack including Advocate Iftaz Muhammad Kakar.

While addressing the participants, Senator Rabbani held the attack on lawyers and communities across the country a challenge for the state.

He further said that the parliament stands really weak today as anyone could launch a siege and attack it. He called for religious implementation of the 1973 constitution for the country to progress.

Raza Rabbani has urged executive, judiciary and military establishment to work within their constitutional parameters. "I don't wish to see a confrontation among state institutions," Rabbani said.

"According to the law, the state's first and foremost responsibility is protecting the lives and property of the people. The weakest state institution is the Parliament."

He added that democratic forces struggled against a dictator and got Article 58(2)(b) removed from the Constitution but now another method has arisen.

The said section of the Constitution was inserted in 1985 by Gen Ziaul Haq and was used by military dictators and presidents to dismiss political governments. It was removed from the Constitution when the 18th Amendment was passed by the Pakistan Peoples Party government in 2010.—NNI

## Ex-AGP granted bail

ISLAMABAD: Suspending the sentence of former Auditor General of Pakistan Akhtar Bulel Rana on Wednesday, Additional Sessions Judge Islamabad West, Syed Faizan Haider, granted him bail against a surety bond of Rs 100,000.

Earlier on August 31, a senior civil judge awarded a one-year sentence to Akhtar Bulel Rana for concealing facts about his dual nationality.

# TIP urges Britain, UAE to freeze assets, bank accounts of Pakistanis

KARACHI: The Chairman Transparency International Pakistan (TIP), Sohail Muzaffar and the Board of Trustees has demanded of the British government and the United Arab Emirates to immediately freeze properties, assets and bank accounts of all Pakistani nationals or Pakistani nationals holding dual nationalities.

This demand has been made on the wake of a major development for implementation of "Rule of Law" in Pakistan, the Supreme Court of Pakistan's decision on 28th July 2017, for

the disqualification of Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif due to non-declaration of Aqama of UAE and income, and the recent developments which have taken place resulting in removal of Mian Muhammad Nawaz Sharif from the office of the Prime Minister.

It also demanded to ask these Pakistanis to produce the tax payment certificates on purchases, from Federal Board of Revenue, Pakistan, and certificate from State Bank of Pakistan verifying the legal transfer of funds from Pakistan, for purpose of Transparency.

The failure on their part to produce such certificates, the Government of United Arab Emirates and Britain should transfer such assets & funds to the Government of Pakistan.—PR

It has further been demanded by Sohail Muzaffar like a USA Citizen staying outside US is required to file annual tax return and assets statements in US also, the Government of Pakistan should frame the same rules for Pakistanis, and cancel withdraw six months non resident's tax filing exemption, as prima facie such exemption is an incentive for corruption, being misused to garnish of UAE Aqama, for buying assets in Europe.

The Chairman TIP has further requested the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan to take Sua Motu notice of this misuse of the law, which resulting in massive corruption money laundering which is badly affecting the economy of Pakistan.—NNI

## Six patients die during YDA's strike

LAHORE: Despite reported deaths of six innocent patients, two in Lahore and four in Faisalabad, young doctors on Wednesday continued their strike to press the government for the acceptance of their demands.

Due to the strike of young doctors, patients at main city hospitals as well as other hospitals of the province had to face hardships. The protesting doctors left the poor patients in limbo in public sector hospitals.

In Lahore, OPDs of Mayo, Ganga Ram, LGH and Jinnah hospitals routine working paralyzed due to the strike. However, in emergency wards senior doctors performed their duties. Principal, Post Graduate Medical Institute, Prof Ghias-un-Nabi Tayyab asked the administrative doctors of LGH to assist doctors in emergency, outdoor and other departments. He asked the professors to incite the Islamic and ethical aspect in under-training doctors.

# PTI to file reference against AJK PM's speech

ISLAMABAD: The Azad Kashmir branch of the Tehrik-e-Insaf is filing a reference against the prime minister of the territory in its Legislative Assembly for his recent statement regarding Kashmir's allegiance to Pakistan, its president announced on Wednesday.

Sohail Mahmood, himself a former prime minister of Azad Kashmir, told a press conference that Prime Minister Farooq Haider violated his oath as chief executive by making a statement against Kashmir's accession with Pakistan.

"We are filing a reference against Farooq Haider as he has violated his oath by giving a ridiculous statement," he said.

According to him, Farooq Haider, who termed the Supreme Court's verdict in the Panama Papers case as a "fixed judgment," had made the controversial statement under directions from former Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif himself.

While his party has been raising the Kashmir issue and the protesting against the Indian forces' atrocities against Kashmiris at the international level, "our own prime minister has tried to damage this cause through an absurd statement," he said.

He said that Farooq Haider's views about Kashmir's accession had been widely known in Kashmir and now he had exposed himself before the whole world.

The PTI, which is holding protests against Farooq Haider's statement, will hold more rallies in the coming days, he added.

# LHC witnesses ugly scene as lawyers storm courtroom

LAHORE: The Lahore High Court on Wednesday witnessed ugly scenes as a group of lawyers stormed the courtroom of Chief Justice Syed Mansoor Ali Shah, made the situation hostile for judges to hold contempt proceedings against the Multan High Court Bar president and other.

The counsel further said that passport issue was not an allegation and the charge was subsequently levied on the basis of mala fide intentions against his client when Rana pointed out Rs 480 billion circular debt on a TV programme.

After hearing brief arguments of Taimoor Aslam Khan, the additional session judge granted bail to his client.

## China felicitates PM

BEIJING: China on Wednesday congratulated Shahid Khaqan Abbasi on becoming Pakistan's new prime minister, in the wake of the supreme court disqualifying former Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif on corruption charges.—NNI

The Chief Justice observed with regret that the whole matter had been given a political colour by the lawyers to protect only one individual.

Both the lawyers facing contempt of court charges for misbehaving with a judge at the Multan seat of LHC. Both contemnors did not appear before the larger bench on Wednesday.

The bench has given last chance to the contemnors to appear before it on August 11 with a warning of issuing non-bailable warrants.

The lawyers gathered outside the courtroom intending to show their strength and anger to the judges for summoning their colleagues through warrants.

Police personnel deployed outside the chief justice's courtroom did not offer any resistance to the aggressive possession of the courtroom, lawyers to, what they said, a delegation led by LHCBA.

President LHCBA and other leaders appeared before the court and stated that they had been trying to calm the situation and anger of the lawyers of Multan. He sought two-week time to ensure compliance of the court's order.

When the bench reminded him of his undertaking to make the contemnors appear, he said general house of the LHCBA-Multan passed a resolution against the court's order and resolved that its president would not appear before the bench.
